Executive Summary

Dawa joined the ISIS Children’s Foundation in April 2008. Her main responsibility is to ensure the care and well being of 133 children, managing ten ISIS Homes with 76 support staff.

Before joining ISIS, Dawa was volunteering for two NGOs, mainly working for girls education scholarships and enhancing village women’s skill in order to assist them with employment opportunities. She also provided counseling services to adolescent youths and their parents on a volunteer basis.

During 1985 to 2004, Dawa worked as an Associate Director for Peace Corps/ Nepal. She managed their Nursing and Community Health Program and project activities, supervising Peace Corps Volunteers.

Dawa also worked as a language instructor for two years at “School for International Training”, teaching Tibetan and Nepali to American Students as apart of their College credit program.

Dawa worked as a High School teacher for approximately 17 years teaching in Government as well as Private schools. She was involved in the “send daughters to school” campaign to increase school enrollment of girls in remote areas of Nepal.

Dawa has a Post Graduate in Counseling/Psychology and a B.A., B. Education.
